



Streets Alive!

Residents are invited to enjoy the County of San Mateo, East Palo Alto and 10 other cities in the county in a new way while taking part in a movement that is sweeping the world on May 1, 2011. Streets Alive builds on the wildly popular Bicycle Sundays where Cañada Road is closed to traffic. Hundreds of walkers, bicyclists, runners and others throng Cañada to enjoy the car-free outdoors. Streets Alive is part of a worldwide movement to turn busy streets into car-free places for fun and exercise. Cities from South American to Northern Europe are turning busy streets into safe streets.

Now it's our turn! The city will join 10 other cities where the City of East Palo Alto will have a **Streets Alive!** non-motorized float in the Annual Cometí Latino Cinco De Mayo Parade from 11:00am to noon. You may be part of our float by walking, running, rolling and dancing. In addition, there will be a Bicycle Rodeo from 1:00-3:00pm during the Cinco de Mayo Festival.

Mobile Skate Park will be at the weekly EPA Farmers' Market to Kick off our Street's Alive! Activities, located behind the East Palo Alto Family YMCA, 550 Bell Street.

We need parent volunteers to help operate the Skate Park and youth are welcome to skate BUT **MUST HAVE AND WEAR A HELMET** or they cannot participate. NO BICYCLES are permitted on the ramps.

Mobile Skate Park Rules & Regulations:

1. Skaters Must be ages 10-18
2. HELMETS, KNEE & ELBOW PADS must be worn at all times.
3. NO skating when wet or raining.
4. NO Motorized vehicles.
5. NO BMX, bicycles or scooters.
6. Skate responsibly within the limits of your capabilities.
7. Only ONE PERSON ON A RAMP at a time.
8. NO graffiti, tagging or stickers.
9. NO drugs or alcohol allowed.
10. NO food, drink or pets in skating area.
11. Be mindful of pedestrian traffic in skating area.
12. HONOR & RESPECT the sport and each other.
13. NO foul language or behavior.
14. DISPOSE OF TRASH in trash receptacles. Additional obstacles (ramps/jumps) may not be used in the skate park.
15. Use ramp elements in their intended way and with respect.
16. No spectators inside the skate park.
17. All participants must skate safely at all times and avoid collisions with other participants.
18. Ramps must be clear of skaters before you proceed.
19. Fighting, graffiti, vandalism, or other aggressive or disruptive behavior is not permissible.
