The City of East Palo Alto has received a Station Area Planning Grant from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) to look at the potential for Dumbarton Rail train service in East Palo Alto. The potential “Station Area” includes Ravenswood and Four Corners, along with several surrounding neighborhoods. The City has hired a team of consultants, led by Design, Community & Environment (DC&E), to create a plan for the future of this Station Area. The plan will consider issues such as the types of businesses and homes that should be built in the Station Area; opportunities to provide jobs for East Palo Alto residents; and street improvements that will help people walk, bike, drive and use public transit. Tonight’s meeting will provide an overview of the project and an opportunity to discuss how the plan can improve community health in East Palo Alto.
