Dear Residents:

This letter is to inform you that the City of East Palo Alto has contracted with Granite Construction Company to perform roadway improvements on Bay Road, Pulgas Avenue, and Woodland Avenue.

The working hours for this project are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday thru Friday. This construction project is anticipated to begin November 16, 2009 and be completed by the end of January 2010.

The construction program will be completed in the following stages:

The project consists of general pavement rehabilitation and asphalt concrete overlay improvements, including asphalt repairs, crack sealing, asphalt concrete overlays, installation of concrete access ramps, and replacement of traffic signal detector loops.

During construction, it may be necessary to prohibit parking on selected streets. We will make every effort to maintain access into driveways but access may be restricted

Granite Construction will place “Temporary No Parking Tow Away” signs prior to the start of any work that may restrict parking. These signs will indicate the date on which this directive will be in effect and we would appreciate your adherence to these temporary restrictions. It may be necessary to have vehicles towed away if they are not moved during the posted times at the owner’s expense.
