BACKGROUND

The City of East Palo Alto has received a Station Area Planning Grant from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) to create the Ravenswood/4 Corners Transit Oriented Development Specific Plan (Specific Plan). The City has hired a team of consultants, led by Design, Community & Environment (DC&E), to create the Specific Plan. The Specific Plan will consider issues such as the types of businesses and homes; opportunities to provide jobs for East Palo Alto residents; and street improvements that will help people walk, bike, drive and use public transit. The City Council appointed a seven-member CAC to oversee the process of creating a community vision for the Specific Plan.
